On European Union Third Countries Citizens' Acceptance to Studies and Schooling at the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad for Bachelor's and Master's Academic Studies Starting the Academic Year of 2024 – 2025

According to the following legal provisions:

- The Law on higher education no. 199/2023, with subsequent amendments;
- The Government Decision no. 433/ 30.03.2022 on the approval of the Nomenclature of fields and specialization/ academic study programs and the structure of the higher education institutions for the academic year of 2022-2023, published in the Official Journal no. 328 bis of April 4, 2022.
- The Government Decision no. 434/ 30.03.2022 on the accredited Master academic fields and study programs and on the numerus clausus of students to be enrolled in the academic year of 2022-2023, published in the Official Journal no. 333 bis of April 5, 2022;
- The Law no. 448/ 2006 on the Protection and Promotion of the Persons with Disabilities Rights, republished, with subsequent amendments;

- The Disposition of the Ministry of National Education no. 3693/ 2024, on the approval of the Framework Methodology on the organization of the admission at Bachelor, Master and Doctoral University Studies;
- The Disposition of the Ministry of National Education no. 3473/ 2017 of March 17, 2017, on the approval of the Methodology for foreign citizens' acceptance to studies and schooling starting the school/ academic year of 2017-2018
- The Charter of the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad, 2019.

CHAPTER I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Art. 1

The foreign citizens are persons having citizenship in a third country to the European Union, proven by holding a valid passport.

Art. 2.

The foreign citizens' schooling at the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad is conducted for places with tuition fee paid in euro.

CHAPTER II. ADMISSION TO STUDIES

SECTION I. Studies in Romanian

Art. 3

(1) The admission to academic studies is in Romanian.

(2) The verification and validation of the documents, certifying the language skills for the candidates to study programs taught in Romania, submitting certificates or certifications of language for at least B1 level, according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, issued by the accredited higher education institutions in Romania that organize the preparatory year of Romanian for foreigners, issued by the lectorates of Romanian language, literature, culture, and civilization at universities from abroad/ the Institute of Romanian Language or the Romanian Cultural Institute, is carried out by a commission formed of specialized teaching staff from the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities, and Physical Education and SportS, approved by the University Senate.

(3) There are exempted from the obligation to submit the certificate of graduation of the initiation course, respectively of the preparatory year, the students submitting Romanian documents of studies (diplomas and certificates) or documents of studies, school transcripts certifying at least 4 consecutive years studied in Romanian in a school unit in the Romanian national system.

(4) The verification of the Romanian language skills for the candidates who do not submit certificates or certifications of language for at least B1 level, according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, issued by the accredited higher education institutions in Romania that organize the preparatory year of Romanian for foreigners, issued by the lectorates of Romanian language, literature, culture, and civilization at universities from abroad/ the Institute of Romanian

Language or the Romanian Cultural Institute, is carried out by taking a multiple choice test and an oral test according to the admission calendar at the subject Modern Languages at the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities, and Physical Education and Sports. Passing the language test is to be confirmed by a proving Certificate which is a mandatory and eliminatory requirement for registration to the admission competition.

(5) For students who took their studies in an international language or in a language of the national minorities, the certification of the oral language skills in Romanian is carried out with the Baccalaureate diploma.

SECTION II. Studies in Foreign Languages

Art. 4

(1) The verification and validation of the documents, certifying the language skills for the candidates to study programs taught in international languages (English, French) and who submit, upon registration, documents of studies, issued by Romanian or foreign education institutions, is carried out by a commission formed of specialized teaching staff from the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities, and Physical Education and Sports, approved by the University Senate.

(2) For the studies carried out in English, the “Vasile Goldis” Western University requires for at least of a B1 level of English knowledge, acknowledging and validating the following exams: PET (score 140-170), FCE, CAE, CPE, BEC, IELTS (at least 4.5), Toefl Ibt (score: 57-86), TOEIC, TRINITY ISE (ISE-1), ECL, BCCE, ECCE, ALCE, ECPE, Ascentis Anglia ESOL, LRN Entry Level Certificate in ESOL International (Entry 3), LRN Entry Level 1 Certificate in ESOL International, LRN Entry Level 2 Certificate in ESOL International, LRN Entry Level 3 Certificate in ESOL International, IELCA, ESOL International ALL Modes (Entry 3), ESOL International ALL Modes Level 1 B2 (GCSE), ESOL International ALL Modes Level 2 C1 (GCSE), ESOL International All Modes Level 3 C2 (GCE A Level), Language Cert in International English for Speakers of Other Languages (IESOL), LCCI, ELSA, Pearson LCCI, level 1 Pearson LCCI English for Business, PTE, FEDE, OXFORD TEST OF ENGLISH (score 81-110). Additional information on the recognized language certificates can be found in the Disposition no. 6063/ 2020 of the Ministry of Education and Research which can be studied at the address https://www.edu.ro/sites/default/files/_fisiere/Legislatie/2020/OMEC_6063.pdf. The above-mentioned certificates have to cover all four language skills (comprehension of the heard text – listening, comprehension of the read text – reading, production of written messages – writing, production of oral messages – speaking).

(3) For the studies conducted in French, the “Vasile Goldis” Western University requires for at least of a B1 level of French knowledge, acknowledging and validating the following exams: DELF, DALF, TCF, TEF, ECL, FEDE. Additional information on the recognized language certificates can be found in the Disposition no. 6063/ 2020 of the Ministry of Education and Research which can be studied at the address https://www.edu.ro/sites/default/files/_fisiere/Legislatie/2020/OMEC_6063.pdf.

(4) The date of issuing of the above-mentioned certificates must not be older than two years.

(5) The certification of language skills for English and French for candidates who do not submit language certificates or certifications of at least B1 level, according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, can also be achieved by taking an online exam, organised as multiple choice and oral tests, according to the admission planning, organised by the subject

Modern Language at the Faculty of Social Sciences, Humanities, and Physical Education and Sport. Passing the language test is to be confirmed by a proofing certificate which is a mandatory and eliminatory requirement for the registration to the admission competition.

Art. 5

(1) The “Vasile Goldis” Western University of Arad provides the candidates with the possibility for registering to the following exams in order to get the language certificates:

English – CAMBRIDGE (PET, FCE, CAE, CPE, BEC, VANTAGE, BEC HIGHER), TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS/ B1, LANGUAGE CERT

French – FEDE

(2) The “Vasile Goldis” Western University of Arad makes available for the candidates training modules for getting these language skills. All these exams and training modules are managed by the BLC-UVVG Centre at the UVVG, according to the exams planning, available at blc@uvvg.ro

Art. 6

(1) The confirmation of the place draws in, implicitly, the admitted candidate’s obligation to participate in a language testing of medical terminology in Romanian, English and French, depending on the selected study program, testing held at the Faculty of Social Sciences, Humanities, Physical Education and Sports of the “Vasile Goldiş” Western University of Arad.

(2) The minimum grade for passing this exam is 7.

(3) If getting a grade lower than 7, the admitted candidate has to participate in an intensive modular extracurricular paid course which ends with a test where the lower limit is 7. If, even after this test, the admitted candidates do not get 7, they have to take a language module under the same terms as the previous one.

(4) There are exempted from this test the persons coming from countries where the official language is the teaching language of the study programs and who certify, with school documents, that their education was performed in the respective language.

SECTION III. Degree I – Admission to Bachelor’s Academic Studies

Art. 7

The foreign citizens may accede to Bachelor’s academic studies at the “Vasile Goldiş” Western University of Arad if fulfilling cumulatively the following requirements:

- a) Have documents certifying the citizenship of a European Union third country;
- b) Are graduates with Baccalaureate diploma or its equivalent, according to the list stipulated in annex 1 which this Methodology is part of (the List of the high school diplomas recognised by the Ministry of Education for the registration of foreign citizens at Bachelor academic studies).

Art. 8

The admission exam planning is as follows:

For bachelor’s university studies, **foreign (non-EU) candidates** are admitted through the evaluation of school performance and personal achievements, according to the evaluation grid (annex no. 1) according to the following calendar::

July 2024 session

8 April – 23 July (17.00) - registration of candidates on the online platform

July 24 - July 25 – evaluation of school performance and personal achievements

July 26 – publication of the results and formulating any appeals within 2 hours from the communication of the results; the settlement of appeals is done on the same day,

July 27 – July 31 – confirmation of places by paying the tuition fee and signing the contract of studies; (copy of receipt/payment order) will be communicated to the faculty secretariat by email no later than July 31; failure to pay the tuition fee within the stipulated deadline will lead to the loss of the place obtained through the competition and to the redistribution of the vacant places.

August 1 – redistribution of candidates on unoccupied places

August 2 – publication of final results

In case of non-occupancy of all places for bachelor's university study programs, the second **admission session for foreign candidates (non-EU) is organized in September 2024** by evaluating school performance and personal achievements, according to the evaluation grid (Annex 3), according to the following calendar:

2 September – 18 September (17.00) - registration of candidates on the online platform

19 September - 20 September – evaluation of school performance and personal achievements

September 20 (17.00) – publication of the results and submission of any appeals within 2 hours from the communication of the results; appeals are settled on the same day,

September 21 – September 24 – confirmation of places by paying the tuition fee and signing the contract of studies; (copy of receipt/ payment order) will be communicated to the faculty secretariat by email no later than September 24; failure to pay the tuition fee within the stipulated deadline will lead to the loss of the place obtained through the competition and to the redistribution of the vacant places.

September 25 – redistribution of candidates on vacant seats

September 27 – publication of final results

Art.10

The application file for the foreign citizens mentioned at art. 7 comprises the following;

- a) Birth certificate – copy and legalised translation into Romanian;
- b) Copy of the document certifying the permanent residence abroad;
- c) Copy of the passport valid for at least six months;
- d) Application for the issuing of the letter of acceptance to studies, stipulated in the annex 2, filled in at all fields;
- e) Copy and legalised translation into Romanian of the Baccalaureate diploma or of its equivalent, authenticated by the corresponding authorities of the issuing country;
- f) Copy and legalised translation into Romanian of the certificate ascertaining the passage of the baccalaureate exam for all current year graduates
- g) Transcripts of records/ diploma supplements – copies related to the undertaken studies;
- h) The certificate for graduation of the preparatory year of Romanian or the language certificate for the language of instruction for the study program which he/ she applies for;
- i) The medical certificate (in an international language) certifying that the person to be enrolled to the studies does not have contagious diseases or other conditions incompatible with his/ her future profession;
- j) Proof of registration fee payment;
- k) Letter of intent in the language of the study program that the candidate intends to undertake;
- l) The table on the selection criteria in the language of the study program that the candidate intends to undertake;

- m) Letter of recommendation from a teaching staff member or mentor for the volunteering activity in the language of the study program that the candidate intends to undertake;
- n) Other documents, relevant for the selection.

Art. 11

The procedure of admission applied to the candidates mentioned at art. 7 is conducted as follows:

- a). candidate registration is carried out using the online registration platform provided by the University at <http://admitere.uvvg.ro> from any desktop computer, laptop, tablet, mobile phone with access to the Internet . The University makes available to candidates through the Permanent Information and Registration Centre a room equipped with the necessary equipment for online registration;
- c). The "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad, through the admission committees of each faculty, evaluates the files, according to the legal regulations in force, and communicates to the Ministry of Education - General Directorate of International Relations and European Affairs the list of persons proposed for the issuance of the letter of acceptance at studies;
- d). the list of candidates will be sent to the Ministry of Education, according to the model submitted by the Ministry of Education; the list will be accompanied by an electronic copy of the candidate's file, according to art. 10. The electronic copy of the file will be made available to the Ministry of Education through platforms or other online means managed by the University or through a portable storage device;
- f). after analyzing the file, the Ministry of Education issues the letter of acceptance to studies;
- g). The Ministry of Education sends letters of acceptance to study at the University of the West "Vasile Goldiș" in Arad;
- h). incomplete files will not be processed, being declared rejected. If the files are completed, the University will resume the steps described in the admission procedure, in order to process them by the Ministry of Education:
- i). the places left unoccupied, by the rejection of the files by the Ministry of Education and/or the non-confirmation of the place by paying 50% of the tuition fee upon confirmation of the place (July session) and the full payment of the tuition fee of the first year of study upon receiving the letter of acceptance at studies, as well as the full payment of the tuition fee for those admitted in the September session, will be redistributed to the candidates on the waiting list in descending order of the points accumulated at the initial evaluation.

Art. 12

(1) Students who completed part-time bachelor studies in another accredited, in Romania or in another state, higher education institutions, can continue their studies in the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad, through admission competition, to the bachelor's academic studies iff cumulatively the following requirements are met:

- a) The candidates submit the application for registration in a higher year in person at the faculty secretariat located at 86 Liviu Rebreanu street, Arad, Romania or by e-mail at until July 22, 2024, or within the available places during September 1-16, 2024;

- b) have documents certifying the foreign citizens;

- c) are graduates with Baccalaureate diploma or equivalent, according to the list stipulated in Annex 1 which is part of the current Methodology (List of high school diplomas recognised by the Ministry of Education for foreign students' registration to bachelor's university studies).
 - d) they are enrolled in a higher education institution of Romania or recognized by the authorities of the state where he/ she took their studies;
 - e) have transcripts of record and syllabi related to the carried-on studies;
- (2) The continuation of studies at the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad can be done after the first year and until the end of the penultimate year of studies, in study programs in the same field of study, subject to compliance with the provisions of art. 7.
- (3) Continuation of studies at the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad is conditional on obtaining the letter of acceptance to studies.

Art. 13

The application file of foreign citizens, mentioned in art. 12, who wish to enrol in a higher year, will contain the following documents:

- ◀ proof of schooling with the results of the exams is supported by the signature and stamp of the issuing unit (supplement to the diploma/transcript/certificate of schooling), signed and stamped
- ◀ the syllabus for each subject studied with the signature and stamp of the issuing unit
- ◀ the official explanatory note on the grading system applied in the educational unit where he/ she studied, as well as the correspondence of this system with the European Transferable Credit System (ECTS) issued by the educational unit where he/ she studied
- ◀ written request stating the year of study for which equivalence is requested, as well as the contact details of the applicant: e-mail, telephone number, address.
- ◀ language certificate for the study program which he/ she is applying for
- ◀ documents written in a language other than Romanian must be translated into Romanian (legalized translation) or into the language of the study program for which you apply
- ◀ proof of payment of the file processing fee: 250 euros

Following the verification of the personal file and the equivalence of the studies carried out by the Commission of equivalence of studies within the faculty, the candidate will be informed of the year of study for which he/ she can register for the admission exam.

Art. 14

The admission procedure applied to the candidates mentioned in art. 12 proceeds as follows:

- a). candidates will submit the application for enrolment in the higher year in physical form, at the faculty secretariat located on 86Liviu Rebreanu street, Arad Romania or they will send it by email to the address admitereansuperior@uvvg.ro until July 22, 2024 or within the limits of the remaining available places, between September 1 and 16, 2024.
- b). The "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad, through the admission committees of each faculty, evaluates the files, according to the regulations in force, and sends the Ministry of Education - General Directorate of International Relations and European Affairs the list of persons proposed for the issuance of the letter of acceptance to studies and copy of files;
- c). the list of candidates will be sent to the Ministry of Education, according to the template submitted by the Ministry of Education; the list will be accompanied by an electronic copy of the candidate's file, according to art. 10. The electronic copy of the file will be made available to the Ministry of Education through platforms or other online means managed by the University or through a portable storage device;
- e). after analysing the file, the Ministry of Education issues a letter of acceptance to studies;
- f). The Ministry of Education sends letters of acceptance to study at the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad;
- g). incomplete files will not be processed, being declared rejected. If the files are completed, the University will resume the steps described in the admission procedure, in order to process them by the Ministry of Education;
- h). the files in physical format of the rejected candidates or those who give up the place obtained will be returned by the University, within 48 hours at most from the submission of the application, without charging any additional fees;

SECTION IV

Degree II – Admission to Master Academic Studies

Art. 15

The foreign citizens may accede to Master academic studies, to programs accredited at the “Vasile Goldiș” Western University of Arad, if they fulfil cumulatively the following requirements:

- a) They have documents certifying the citizenship in a third country to the European Union;
- b) They are graduates with Bachelor diploma or its equivalent;

Art. 16 The application file for the foreign citizens mentioned at art. 15 comprises the following;

- a) Birth certificate – copy and legalised translation into Romanian;
- b) Copy of the document certifying the permanent residence abroad, legalized translation into Romanian;
- c) Copy of the passport;
- d) Application for the issuing of the letter of acceptance to studies, stipulated in the annex 2, filled in at all fields;
- e) Copy and legalised translation into Romanian of the Bacalaureate diploma or of its equivalent, authenticated by the corresponding authorities of the issuing country;
- f) Copy and legalised translation into Romanian of the Bachelor diploma or of its equivalent, authenticated by the corresponding authorities of the issuing country
- g) Transcripts of records/ diploma supplements – copies related to the undertaken studies;
- h) The certificate for graduation of the preparatory year of Romanian or the language certificate, where applicable, according to art. 3, 4 and 5;
- i) The medical certificate (in an international language) certifying that the person to be enrolled to the studies does not have contagious diseases or other conditions incompatible with his/ her future profession;
- j) Proof of registration fee payment;
- k) Letter of intent in the language of the study program that the candidate intends to undertake;
- l) The table on the selection criteria in the language of the study program that the candidate intends to undertake;
- m) Letter of recommendation from a teaching staff member or mentor for the volunteering activity in the language of the study program that the candidate intends to undertake;
- n) Other documents, relevant for the selection.

Art. 17

The procedure of admission applied to the candidates mentioned at art. 15 is conducted as follows:

- a) The candidates' registration is conducted using the online platform provided by the University at the address <http://admitere.uvvg.ro> from any device type desktop, laptop, tablet, mobile phone with Internet access. The University provides the candidates, by the Permanent Information and Registration Centre, with a hall equipped with the necessary devices for online registration;
- b) By the faculty related commissions of admission, the “Vasile Goldiș” Western University of Arad reviews the files, according to the applicable regulations and submits to the Ministry of Education – the General Directorate for International Relations and European Affairs the list with the persons proposed for the issuing of the letters of acceptance to studies;

- c) The candidates' list is to be sent to the Ministry of Education, according to the template provided by the Ministry of Education;
- d) The lists are to be accompanied by an e-copy of the candidate's file according to art. 16. The e-copy of the file is to be submitted to the Ministry of Education by platforms or other online means managed by the University or by portable storage device;
- e) The Ministry of Education sends the letters of acceptance to the studies to the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad;
- f) The incomplete files are not to be processed, being declared rejected. If the files are completed, the University is to repeat the previously described steps in the admission procedure, for them to be processed by the Ministry of Education;
- g) The paper-based files of the rejected candidates or of those giving up their place are to be returned by the University in at most 48 hours since the submission of the application without additional fees.

CHAPTER III. ENROLMENT TO STUDIES

Art. 18

The enrolment to academic studies is subject to the passing of the admission exam/ competition and to obtaining the letter of acceptance to studies issued by the Ministry of Education.

Art. 19

The enrolment to academic studies at the Bachelor academic study program of Physical and Sport Education is subject to the passing of the tests for specific skills.

Art. 20

The foreign citizens' enrolment is to be made by Rector's decision, according to the planning established by the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad, and according to the applicable law.

Art. 21

The enrolment for the foreign non-EU candidates, who are declared admitted, is conducted within 30 days since the date of the reception of the letter of acceptance issued by the ministry, after signing the contract of studies and paying entirely the tuition fee for the 1st year of studies, the students taking a program of teaching activities catching up.

Art. 22

(1). Upon enrolment, the candidates are to submit the study and identity documents from the application file, in original, together with the letter of acceptance to studies, the passport with valid visa for "studies," and the signed contract of studies, in original;

(2). The original study documents issued by countries which are member of the Convention on Hague Apostil must be endorsed by the competent authorities from the issuing countries, with Hague Apostil.

(3). The original study documents issued in states which are not part of the Convention on the Hague Apostil are to be over-legalised by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from the issuing country and by the embassy/ counsellor's office of Romania in the respective country.

Art. 23

Upon enrolment, the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad is to register in the school documents the foreign citizens' names according to the passport data. Same name is to be

registered also on the documents issued upon the completion of the studies (diploma, diploma supplement).

Art. 24

The “Vasile Goldiș” Western University of Arad has the obligation to conclude contracts of studies between the enrolled students and the University Rector, according to the applicable law.

Art. 25

After enrolment, the foreign citizens are registered in the official academic record with a single number valid for the entire schooling time at the specialisation/ study program where they have been admitted.

CHAPTER IV. FINAL PROVISIONS

Art. 26

The minimum amount of the tuition fees for foreign citizens from third countries is stipulated by the Government Ordinance no. 22/2009, approved with changes by the Law no. 1/2010.

Art. 27

(1). The “Vasile Goldiș” Western University of Arad is to submit to the Ministry of Education the places for the foreign citizens with the compliance with the Numerus Clausus of students to be enrolled, according to the applicable regulations.

(2). The candidates’ files are submitted to the Ministry of Education to issue the letter of acceptance to studies according to the admission planning approved by the University Senate. The admission planning is also to be submitted to the Ministry of Education.

(3). The foreign students’ enrolment is performed according to the established planning by the University Senate. The enrolment planning is sent to the Ministry of Education for information.

Art. 28

The foreign citizens obtaining Romanian citizenship may take a study place against fee, at the amount established by the Board of Directors for the Romanian citizens, provided that they passed the admission competition organised in a legally established session, according to the own regulations.

Art. 29

The letter of acceptance to studies is valid only for the higher education institution for which it has been issued, starting with the academic year for which it has been issued and for the respective academic degree. Any change in the academic path opposing the specifications of the initial letter of acceptance is to be regulated upon the request of the involved educational institution, by the Ministry of Education issuing a new letter of acceptance.

Art. 30

The enrolment to studies, the temporary or final academic mobility, the change of the field of studies and the re-enrolment are performed exclusively with the approval of the Ministry of Education.

Art. 31

The foreign citizens have the following obligations:

- a) To observe the Romanian Constitution and the laws of the Romanian state;
- b) To observe the University Charter, the Regulations on Students’ Professional Activity, the

- Internal Regulations of the University, the Code on Students' Rights and Obligations and the University Code of Ethics and Professional Deontology;
- c) To observe the provisions of this Methodology.

Art. 32

The provisions of this Methodology are to be completed with the eventual further regulations of the Ministry of Education, and with the decisions to be taken by the University Senate.

Art. 33

This Methodology has been endorsed accordingly in the meeting of the Board of Directors of January 25, 2024, and approved by the Senate of the "Vasile Goldiș" Western University of Arad in its meeting of January 26, 2024, revised on February 16, 2024.

The candidates' selection is performed in decreasing order of the accumulated scoring, the minimum score for passing being 50 points. In this regard, the candidates are to fill in and submit to the file the table on the selection criteria. The distinction between candidates with same score is made according to the following successive criteria:

- a. Decreasing order of the average grade at the Baccalaureate exam;
- b. Decreasing order of the average grade at Biology
- c. Decreasing order of the average grade at Chemistry
- d. Decreasing order of the average grade at Physics
